We're actively engaged in desk research and conducting online surveys. These steps are essential for our work in Work Package 2, where we're focusing on mapping and categorizing case studies in AI and entrepreneurship.



KEY STEPS FOR WORK PACKAGE 2:

- **Creating a Framework:** Developing a methodological framework and a questionnaire for interviews with experts to gather valuable insights
- **Identifying Best Practices:** Researching and interviewing professionals to identify and categorize best practices for business setup and growth
- **Producing Educational Videos:** Creating videos to showcase these best practices in action
- **Building a Digital Database:** Developing a user-friendly database containing case studies, best practices, and more. The database will be tested for functionality and translated into various languages for wider accessibility

OBJECTIVE

Our goal is to compile a comprehensive resource of AI tools that promote digital readiness, resilience, and capacity development among female entrepreneurs and VET teachers. This compendium will help them leverage AI to improve their business operations and teaching practices.


